With her colleagues, Kim acted as national counsel for a leading window manufacturer, coordinating litigation with local counsel to effectively and favorably resolve claims throughout the country.

Kim sat second chair at trial defending an architect against a construction defect claim by a developer for \$9 million. Pre-trial the demand was reduced to \$3 million, but after two weeks of trial, the twelve-member jury returned a unanimous verdict in favor of the defendant. The verdict was featured in *North Carolina Lawyers*



Weekly. Kim also successfully represented an architecture firm at arbitration against a developer with a multi-million dollar claim. After arbitration, the matter was resolved for under \$10,000.
